<p>R.10. The tickets referred to in Rule R.9 shall be made available to the Visiting Club in blocks corresponding to the blocks of seating ("Seating Blocks") in the area of the Home Club's Stadium for visiting supporters, such blocks to be designated by reference to the points at which segregation of home and visiting supporters can occur. There shall be no maximum or minimum number of seats in a Seating Block and any question as to the size of a Seating Block or the location of a segregation point shall be determined by the Board.</p>	<p>To take effect beginning Season 2017/18:</p> <p>R.10. The tickets referred to in Rule R.9 must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">R.10.1 be made available to the Visiting Club in blocks corresponding to the blocks of seating ("Seating Blocks") in the area of the Home Club's Stadium for supporters of the Visiting Club, such Seating Blocks to be designated by reference to the points at which segregation of supporters of the Home and Visiting Clubs can occur (and, for the avoidance of doubt, there shall be no maximum or minimum number of seats in a Seating Block and any question as to the size of a Seating Block or the location of a segregation point shall be determined by the Board);R.10.2 be allocated so as to ensure that supporters of the Visiting Club are located in one or more segregated, self-contained area(s) of the Stadium; andR.10.3 (subject to the approval of the relevant local authority) be allocated so as to ensure that, at a minimum, one Seating Block in which supporters of the Visiting Club will be located is situated 'pitch-side' (ie, the front row of such Seating Block is the row closest to the pitch in the relevant stand that is available for general admission).
