Purpose of the Role	
<p>Recruit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Actively pursue opportunities to increase the membership of the network. Encourage the establishment of democratic supporter groups in the network. Promote the benefit of supporter engagement and dialogue. Actively promote the importance of democratic supporter representation in football. Assist supporter trusts in acquiring and increasing an equity stake in their football clubs. <p>Manage</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist supporter groups to increase their membership and develop their organisation and influence. Promote the development of governance best practice across the network. Organise regular meetings of the network. Facilitate and manage Structured Dialogue with the administrators of the competitions covered by the network. Monitor and manage the governance of supporter groups and trusts in the network. Identify the training and support needs of supporter representatives, groups and trusts. Ensure that all supporter representatives are provided with appropriate training and guidance to undertake their duties. Provide appropriate training for supporter elected directors. <p>Support</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Actively promote dialogue and positive relationships between supporters and clubs. Promote and develop links between football supporters. Assist clubs and supporters in developing their relationships in their local communities. Support FSA colleagues on matters covered by the network. Assist FSA affiliates to meet their governance requirements including General Meetings and elections. Provide first responder advice to members and supporter group representatives on matters of governance and legal responsibilities. Provide feedback from the networks to influence proactively the development of FSA campaign work. <p>General</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Promote and protect the interests of the FSA and its members. Actively promote diversity and oppose all forms of discrimination. Promote and develop the support for Association Football and goodwill between football supporters. Initiate and support campaigns on issues of concern to football supporters and FSA members. Build membership of the FSA amongst football supporters and supporter groups in England and Wales with the specific aim of championing the role of supporters in achieving good governance in football clubs and the game as a whole. Support FSA members and colleagues in the representation of football supporters. Work with FSA colleagues to develop strong working relationships with the FA, leagues and clubs. Work with FSA colleagues to support the development of good governance in football. Support FSA National Council members in their work representing members with appropriate briefings and advice. Contribute to the broader work of the FSA as part of the FSA staff team. Work flexibly in line with the requirements and priorities of the FSA.
